All players must play 1/2 the game.

One coach from each team is on the field at all times.

Active substitution is allowed.

No Goalkeepers.

Goal kicks and corner kicks will be used.

Throw-ins- second tries are permitted.

Referees have the final say on all calls.

All indirect kicks on penalty kicks.

No offsides

Ball Size: Size 3

of Players on Field: 6

Time of Play: 4- 10 minute quarters *(Note: Time may be adjusted if change is agreed upon by coaches and referee. Referee wil have the final determination. Example: inclement weather)*

Special Rules:

All players must play 1/2 the game.

One coach from each team is on the field at all times.

Active substitution is allowed.

Goal keepers are introduced at this age.

Goal keepers must have goalie shirt to distinguish their role.

Second tries are permitted on throw-ins.

All indirect kicks on penalty kicks. No off-sides.

Referees have final say on all calls.

1st & 2nd Grade Girls/Boys

Ball Size: Size 4

of Players on Field: 8

Time of Play: 4- 12 minute quarters *(Note: Time may be adjusted if change is agreed upon by coaches and referee. Referee wil have the final determination. Example: inclement weather)*

Special Rules:

All players must play 1/2 the game.

One coach from each team is on the field at all times.

Active substitution is allowed.

Goal keepers must release the ball within 6 seconds.

Goal keepers must have goalie shirt to distinguish their role.

Second tries are permitted on throw-ins.

All indirect kicks on penalty kicks.

No off-sides.

Half-backs are introduced at this age.

Referees have final say on all calls.

No coaches on the field- must be in designated coach's box on sidelines.

Free substitution when permitted under USSF guidelines.
